

61st Westphalian Elite-Auction

Online-Auction in two parts

Münster: The 61st Westphalian Elite-Auction will take place online. 58 highly talented dressage and show jumping horses are up for sale. The horses will move into their boxes in Münster-Handorf on April 1. They can be inspected and tried out in daily training until April 10. In addition to young prospects, the collection includes highly placed competition horses.

For the 61st Westphalian Elite-Auction in spring 2021, the Westfälisches Pferdestammbuch e.V. presents a highly interesting collection of dressage and show jumping horses. The lot of 36 dressage and 19 show jumping horses is completed by three talented riding ponies. In addition to young riding horses that are at the very beginning of a promising career, the collection includes horses that are experienced in competitions. Two candidates of the dressage lot have already been placed up to advanced level.

Due to the current herpes and corona situation, the auction will be held as an online auction. At onlineauction.westfalenpferde.de the collection with complete pedigrees, photos and videos is available for viewing. Registered users also have access to x-ray pictures and a veterinary examination report. Due to the outbreak of the Equine Herpes Virus, the training time of the auction horses at the Westfälisches Pferdezentrum will be shortened. The horses are expected to be stabled in Münster-Handorf on April 1. The training of the horses can be watched from April 2. A test ride is also possible from April 2 to 10 after a prior consultation with the auction sales team. During the Easter holidays, up-to-date training videos of the horses will be produced and afterwards published on the internet. Bids can be submitted from April 8. The auction has been separated into dressage and show jumping lots. The BidUp of the dressage horses will start on Sunday, April 11 at 2 pm. The collection of show jumpers will be auctioned off afterwards.

This year, the title of the auction brochure is decorated by the Fürstenball/Riccio daughter Frau Holle. The bay mare, who comes from the successful breeding of the Rawert family, changed hands at the Westphalian Elite Auction 2015. Under the saddle of the young rider Jana Schrödter, the mare has already collected numerous successes in the dressage ring. Another Westphalian auction horse, Florenz A, has moved in with the Schrödter family. They purchased the Fürstenball son bred by Heinrich Aarnink, Nordhorn, at a Westphalian Youngster Auction earlier in 2021.
